

Intended use


The intended use of the Truss is the treatment of reducible inguinal hernia. The Truss may be worn at any time.

Info: Truss may be right-sided, left-sided or double-sided. Double-sided Truss is shown on front cover; single-sided Truss is shown in instructions.

Application



- 1. Open the front snaps.
- 2. Unbuckle the leg strap(s).
- 3. If rupture is protruding, lie down. Reduce rupture size to normal by using the palm of your hand to gently push rupture upward and in as shown in fig. 2. If necessary, cough to locate exact position of rupture opening. BE SURE TO PLACE THE PAD AT THIS EXACT OPENING.
- 4. Snap the Truss around your abdomen as shown in fig. 3. ENSURE THE PAD IS PLACED AT THE POINT OF RUPTURE.



- 5. Pull the adjustable back straps outward as shown in fig. 4 until the Truss fits snugly. When the Truss feels secure, release the strap ends, as shown in fig. 5. The buckles will automatically prevent the straps from slipping.
- 6. Adjust the leg strap with the buckle at back of Truss as shown in fig. 5 until the fit is comfortably snug. Test for proper adjustment of Truss by sitting down. You should be able to sit down comfortably wearing the Truss. If not, readjust.

Info: When the Truss is properly adjusted, Truss back is above hip line as shown in fig. 6. The pad must be below abdomen at point of rupture as shown in fig. 6.

Info: One adjustment is usually sufficient. After Truss is adjusted properly, put it on as you would any other undergarment.

Removal

To remove Truss, unsnap the front and step out of the Truss. Check the Truss after each laundering to ensure buckles are correctly positioned.

Cleaning and Maintenance

Hand wash Truss gently, using mild soap. Air dry.

▲ NOTICE: DO NOT use detergent or bleach to clean Truss. DO NOT iron Truss.

Info: Repeated laundering may remove the wax lubricant from snaps. If snaps become difficult to operate, rub a little candle wax on the snaps.

Thirty-Day Limited Warranty
